## From the Pastor

May was a good month in ministry, and I'm excited to present this new newsletter for the church and community as the central hub for all of our information and events!

In May, our children attended the Associational Children's Camp at Falls Creek. We took 17 kids and saw 3 decisions made for Christ. We also had our second youth-led service on Sunday morning with Owen Pettit preaching.

On Sunday mornings, we are continuing through John's gospel, and we look forward to taking our youth to Falls Creek June 8-12.

In my morning quiet times, I am currently reading through Leviticus, which is a book many people skip over because it is repetitive and, honestly, kind of dry. It reads like a city ordinance code or set of bills presented awaiting the signature of the president. It's really not that exciting.

It reads that way because that's what it was. Leviticus, being part of the Torah, was Israel's national civic law. It was for Israel what the Constitution and Bill of Rights are for us. Our Constitution and Bill of Rights are based on John Locke's political philosophy, which was based on Torah, particularly concerning the equality of all people under God. That is why there are so many protections for the common people built into our Constitution and Bill of Rights that we don't typically see under law systems like Sharia or other authoritarian forms of government. Leviticus begins with protections for the people so their state and religious leaders could not take advantage of them, and the key term in that part of the Law is forgiveness.

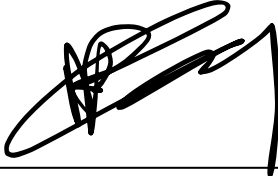

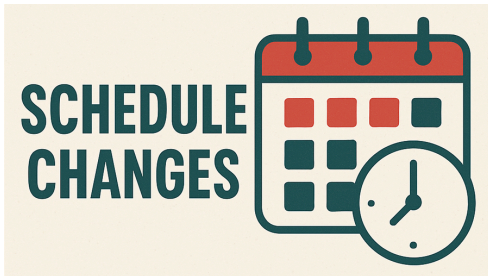
